Paradise Sewer Project Advances Environmental Review

WWTF Sites near Skyway Crossroads and Media Way Under Analysis

Paradise, CA — February 6, 2026 — The Town of Paradise is continuing preparation of a Subsequent Environmental Impact Report (SEIR) for the Paradise Sewer Project and has begun analysis of two potential Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) sites along Skyway corridor as part of the environmental review process. The Skyway Crossroads WWTF site under analysis is near Crossroads adjacent to Town limits and the Skyway South WWTF site is near Media Way, approximately 1.6 miles southwest of Town limits.

The SEIR is currently in development and anticipated for public release in April. In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the SEIR will evaluate potential environmental impacts associated with the proposed project, analyze reasonable project alternatives, compare potential WWTF locations, and include a “No Project” alternative to examine conditions that would occur if the project were not implemented.

“The SEIR process is designed to ensure that all reasonable alternatives are evaluated in a transparent and objective manner,” said Mike O’Brien, Interim Town Manager for the Town of Paradise. “Studying the Skyway South and Skyway Crossroads WWTF site alternatives, along with the No Project alternative, allows the community and decision-makers to better understand potential environmental considerations before any decisions are made.”

The Paradise Sewer Project will establish a centralized wastewater collection and treatment system to improve public health protections, reduce reliance on septic systems, support long-term community recovery, and help protect groundwater resources. Project planning and environmental review are being conducted incrementally and in alignment with available funding and regulatory requirements.

Upon release of the Draft SEIR, anticipated in April 2026, the Town will post a review draft that will include a 45-day public review period and public meetings. All written comments received will be considered and addressed as part of the Final SEIR, consistent with CEQA requirements.


